The Productivity Commission has released the interim report of the Future Drought Fund (FDF) review. The review is assessing the effectiveness of the FDF and its programs in supporting farmers and communities prepare for drought. It is required by legislation under the *Future Drought Fund Act* 2019.

Tasmania's Regional Drought Risk and Resilience Reports

Data analysis will soon be underway to inform robust drought and related climate impact reports for the North, Northwest and Southern regions of Tasmania. The regional research questions are:

- What has been the prevalence, severity and impacts of drought?
- What is the likely prevalence, severity and impact of droughts in the future?
- What are the vulnerabilities, gaps in preparedness and adaptive capacity for drought and other related permanent transitions to a changing climate?

These reports will be critical to the regional drought resilience planning activities which will soon commence in the North, Northwest and Southern regions. The planning process will be locally owned through partnerships of local government, industry and the community.
