Projects selected for Long-term Trials of Drought Resilient Farming Practices Grants

The Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry have just announced the projects selected in the Future Drought Fund's Long-term Trials of Drought Resilient Farming Practices Grant program.

The \$38 million program supports a number of projects to test innovative farming practices and their effectiveness in building drought resilience over several years.

Grants of up to \$8 million (GST exclusive) per project have been awarded to successful consortia who will undertake activities in consultation with farmers across a broad range of geographical distributions, landscapes and production systems.
